The teaching release time is for working with students by:

- Withdrawing a group of students from classroom(s) – **in addition** to their regular mathematics class lesson
- Working with a small group of students in their classroom – **in addition** to their regular mathematics class lesson
- Working with a small group of students (with their teacher observing) in their classroom as part of transitioning the students back into their normal mathematics programme
- Reflection time after a session e.g. 30 teaching time and 5-10 minutes reflection (part of this reflection time would be during the transition time of the groups)

The MST position does not include working to support teachers' pedagogical development. The MST's normal classroom mathematics lessons are also not included in this time. Study and planning should come out of non-contact time.

The following examples are of a **0.2 MST**. If you 0.4 then you would choose two of the options per day.

- Released for an hour and ten minutes a day for four days a week. NB: The MST’s main focus are the students who are well below.
